### Legislation

HB 279 - Tax Credit Scholarships
Status: Signed by Governor

Revised the Montana Tax Credit Scholarship Program, after our landmark win at the U.S. Supreme Court. Raised the 100% tax credit from \$150 to \$200,000 allowing even more kids to attend the school of their choice.

2 HB 112 - Save Women's Sports

Status: Signed by Governor

Requires athletic teams to be designated based on biological sex. Bans biological males from competing on female sports teams.

HB 140 - Ultrasound before Abortion

Status: Signed by Governor

Requires that a pregnant woman be given the opportunity to view an active ultrasound, and listen to the fetal heartbeat before undergoing an abortion.

HB 167 - Referendum to adopt Born Alive Infant Protection Act

Will appear on the ballot

Bans infanticide. Requires health care providers to perform the necessary actions to save the life of any infant bornalive, including infants born-alive after a botched abortion.

HB 171 - Abortion Pill Protocols

Status: Signed by Governor

Bans "do it yourself" at-home abortions using mail-order drugs. Also bans abortion-inducing drugs from being dispensed in public school clinics.

6 HB 349 - Protect Freedom of Association and Speech on Campuses

Status: Signed by Governor

Strengthens the freedom of association and freedom of speech (including religious speech) at public colleges and universities

HB 229 - No Abortion Coverage in Health Exchanges

Status: Signed by Governor

Prohibits health insurance plans offered through the health insurance exchange in Montana from covering abortions.

8 SB 149 - Healthcare Sharing Ministries Status: Passed, became law.

Exempts Christian healthcare sharing ministries from regulation as insurance companies in Montana.

9 SB 172 - Religion is Essential Act Status: Signed by Governor

Prohibits the government from treating churches differently than any other essential business during an emergency or natural dieaster.

SB 215 - Religious Freedom Restoration Act Status: Signed by Governor

Protects the free exercise of religion as a fundamental right, and requires courts to use the "strict scrutiny" legal standard in cases regarding the free exercise of religion.

SB 280 - Sex Designation on Birth Certificates
Status: Signed by Governor

Voided the Bullock-era administrative rule that allowed individuals to retroactively change the sex on their birth certificate without a court order.

SB 99 - Parental Permission for Sex Education Status: Signed by Governor

Establishes parameters for k-12 sexual education. Requires school districts to inform parents or guardians when events or courses on human sexuality will be held or taught. Allows parents to opt their children out of sex education if they choose, and prohibits a school district from allowing any abortion services provider to offer materials or instruction at a school.

SB 99 - Parental Permission for Sex Education Status: Signed by Governor

Establishes parameters for k-12 sexual education. Requires school districts to inform parents or guardians when events or courses on human sexuality will be held or taught. Allows parents to opt their children out of sex education if they choose, and prohibits a school district from allowing any abortion services provider to offer materials or instruction at a school.
