- 1 HB 268 - Conciliation Rules for Divorce**
Allows those who have filed for divorce to suspend or terminate the proceedings while they pursue a path of reconciliation.
Status: Signed by Governor
- 2 HB 284 - Ban on Doctor Prescribed Suicide**
Status: Died in Senate
Vote: Vote listed was from 2nd Reading
- 3 HB 302 - Personhood Amendment**
Would outlaw abortion by defining that life begins at conception. As a constitutional amendment, the bill needed to receive 100 "yes" votes total between both houses.
Status: Died in Senate
Vote: Vote listed was from 3rd Reading
- 4 HB 500 - Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act**
Would prohibit the abortion at 20 weeks.
Status: Passed both houses. **Vetoed by Governor**
- 5 SB 100 - Ultrasound Before Abortion**
Status: Passed both houses. **Vetoed by Governor**
- 6 SB 354 - Ban on Infanticide**
Status: Passed both houses. **Vetoed by Governor**
- 7 HB 735- Campus Free Speech Act**
Status: Passed both houses. **Vetoed by Governor**
- 8 SB 147 - Ban Human Trafficking**
Status: Signed by Governor
- 9 HB 173 - Revise Student/Teacher Sexual Consent Laws**
This bill makes it clear that a student may not consent to a sexual relationship with a teacher or other school employee.
Status: Signed by Governor
- 10 HB 282 - Protect Vulnerable Persons From Sexual Misconduct**
This bill makes it clear that a resident in a youth treatment facility may not consent to a sexual relationship with any employee of the facility.
Status: Signed by Governor

Status: Did not pass 2nd reading in House

 This bill makes it clear that a resident in a youth treatment facility may not consent to a sexual relationship with any employee of the facility.
Status: Signed by Governor
